
This Weekend you will get to preview this year's *Quilt*. It is entitled "Sparkling Chrysanthemum" As you will see it is beautiful!

The Grade 2 teacher will work independently as well as in collaboration with the Grade 1 teacher to insure that the curriculum is taught effectively and classroom management is well executed.


